DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS

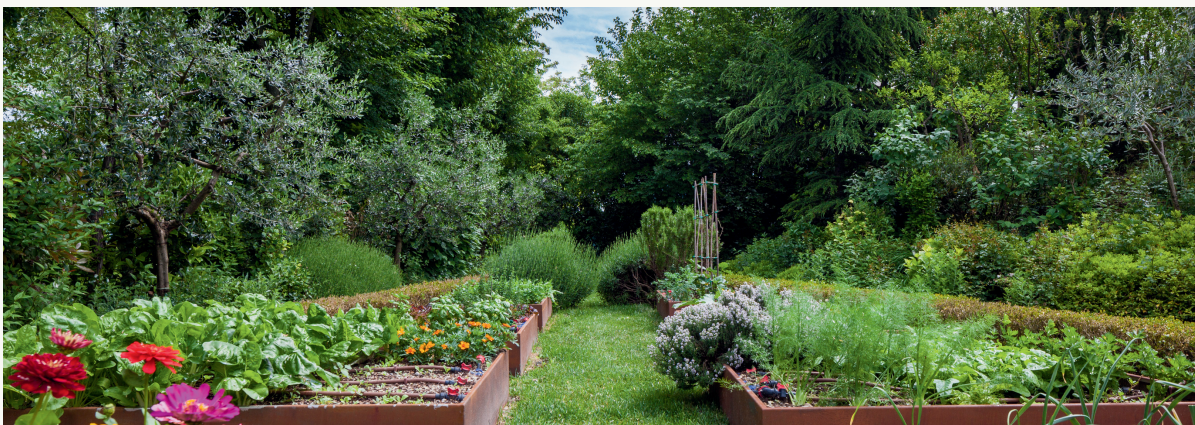
